Omelet made with 2 eggs and melted cheese

- **Turkey ham Cheese omelet**
Omelet made with 2 eggs, turkey ham and melted cheese
Optional: bacon available upon request
- **Vegetable omelet**
Omelet made with 2 eggs, bell peppers, onion and tomato
Optional: bacon available upon request

- **Breakfast sandwich**
Choose your filling:
 - Classic: Fried eggs (2), bacon, turkey ham, cheese tomato and mayonnaise
 - Vegetarian: Fried eggs (2), cheese, tomato and mayonnaise
- **Grilled cheese & tomato**
Grilled white or brown bread with melted cheese and tomato
- **American style pancakes**
Three small American-style pancakes
Served with:
 - Seasonal fresh fruit
